

ACSO Most Valuable Player (MVP) Volunteer Award Nomination Form 2022

Applications are being accepted now through **Tuesday, July 19, 2022** for ACSO's 27th Annual Most Valuable Player (MVP) Volunteer Awards. The awards are designed to give recognition to a few of the hundreds of dedicated, hardworking and committed volunteers that orchestras depend on every day.

The MVP Volunteer Award is not a competition, but an opportunity for your extraordinary volunteer to be recognized publicly. An administrative staff leader of an ACSO member organization may submit one completed nomination form, which constitutes the sole basis of the award being given. Nominations may be made for an individual volunteer, a volunteer committee, or a volunteer organization (such as a league or guild). ACSO will publicly announce the award winners in August 2022 and winners will be presented at ACSO's Annual meeting during the 2022 Annual Meeting in August (date TBD).

ACSO promotes diversity, equity, and inclusion values and principles. As such, we encourage nominators to consider submitting diverse candidates who meet the award criteria.

NOMINATION QUESTIONS

1. Organization Name
2. Nominator's Name and Title
3. Nominator's Email and Phone
4. Name, Address, and Email of Volunteer, Volunteer Committee, or Volunteer Organization being nominated
5. Description of volunteer Project, Service, or Achievement (Give some examples or be descriptive about what this individual or group has done to uplift or build your organization. What kind of work have they done to make them stand out? Your words will be used during the awards presentation, so please be thoughtful.) Appx 250 words
6. Reason for Your Nomination (Think about what makes this person a good volunteer and how their contributions have impacted your organization.) Appx 250 words.
7. Upload a high res photo of the nominee
